TREASURER'S REPORT:

Treasurer Melanie Austen presented the report for the period ending June 30, 2018, with a total balance of \$48,765.53. Details of the reports were provided via email and at the meeting. Hearing no objections, the report will be will be filed for review.

 Chair Linda Lucena has decided on a design for the chopstick labels for the SART program and Girls On The Run events.

TECHNICAL COMMITTEE REPORTS:

2018/2019 Budget:

The budget was submitted to all members via email on August 1, 2018. During the review and approval process at this meeting there were 4 changes and one correction –

- The annual Planning Retreat included an additional line item approved at the retreat which is to add \$3,750.00 for to a GOTR (Girls On The Run) sponsorship at the Diamond Level. This is one-half of the Diamond Level Sponsor amount and SI Chico will be donating the other \$3,750.00.
- The Focus Program line item was reduced by \$3,000. In order to help pay for this new GOTR line item.
- The Sober Grad line item was removed (\$400.00) entirely.
- The 2018 Brewfest Expense line item was reduced by \$350 and transferred to the GOTR line item keeping the total Estimated Disbursements for the 2018/2019 Budget year at \$37,334.67.
- The correction was the date listed on the budget, 2018 Brewfest instead of 2019
 Brewfest

There was a motion to approve the above action by Sally Mendez, Seconded by Susan Bandstra and approved unanimously by the members present.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

VP Babette Maiss announced the new SIBR Newsletter, electronic edition, and asked that members share their committee and other important information with her to be included in future newsletters. There is a sign-up pop-up for adding information to the newsletter.

NEW BUSINESS:

- SIBR will help host the 2019 Winter District Meeting in conjunction with District 2 and the dates and times will be announced as plans progress. Kim Sayers volunteered to chair this committee.
- SIBR received a request from the SI Chico club to partner with them for a Legacy project for the 2021 100-year anniversary of Soroptimist International. This will be explored more with SI Chico by the board.
- Enloe Hospital SART program forwarded a 'wish list' to Linda Lucena, (SIBR Anti-Trafficking committee) which Linda will email to all members for their review and possible personal donations.
