- In 2012, Soroptimists reported on 3,727 projects to promote women and girls' participation in education and leadership. Nearly 110,000 women and girls were educated, empowered and enabled.

- Each year, more than \$1.5 million is disbursed through cash awards at various levels of the organization.
- Many recipients have overcome enormous obstacles including poverty, domestic violence, and drug and alcohol abuse.
- The awards may be used to offset any costs associated with efforts to attain higher education, such as books, childcare and transportation.
